RE: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - DUNLOP TOWNSVILLE 400 - TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT.

Please find Traffic Management and Transport related information below regarding the upcoming Dunlop Townsville 400 event. Specific Traffic Management plans have been prepared in an effort to minimise any disturbance or interruptions to local traffic conditions.

To assist with minimising disruptions to the local area, non essential travel to and around the event venue is requested from residents and visitors. Using Public transport to get to the venue is also recommended.

Q: Where can I park?

A: Limited paid car parking is available at the following locations:

- Leighton's Devine Southbank Site; accessible from Saunders Street.
- Dean Street Car Park
- Townsville Showgrounds
- Rear of Hyde Park Shopping Centre

Pre-sold Car Parking is available at the following locations:

- Townsville State High School by contacting the school directly on (07) 4721 8777.
- Railway Estate Primary School by contacting the school directly on (07) 4720 8333.

Q: What road closures will be in place?

A: The following roads will be closed between approximately midnight Tuesday July 7th until 4pm Monday July 13th.

- Charters Towers road between Flinders Street and Boundary road.
- Boundary road between Railway Ave and Charters Towers road.

Parking restrictions will be enforced by local Police between approximately 7am Friday July 10th and 6pm Sunday July 12th. Residents and Businesses in the following areas are required to collect appropriate vehicle accreditation stickers from the event Accreditation Centre at Railway Estate Community Centre on First Street.

- First Street
- Second Street
- Third Street
- Third Avenue
- Flowers Street
- Railway Avenue (west side of railway)

Q: Is there any disabled parking?

A: There will be disabled parking available on Charters Towers Road accessible from the southern side. There will be appropriate signage approaching the venue and directing patrons to the nearby disabled viewing platform.

Q: Are there any buses to the Event?

A: Local Company Sunbus will have regular services running throughout the event and be dropping patrons near to each of the Main Gates. Further information on routes and timings is available through the downloadable pamphlet or by referring to the Sunbus website on www.sunbus.com.au. Alternatively you can contact (07) 4725 8482.

Q: Where can I obtain Ferry information for Magnetic Island?

A: Passenger Ferries are available through Sunferries with timetable information available on the downloadable pamphlet or by contacting (07) 4726 0800.

Vehicle Ferries are available through Fantasea with timetable information available on the downloadable pamphlet or by contacting (07) 4772 5422.

Q: Where can I drop off and pickup from the venue?

A: There will be dedicated pickup and drop off areas at the following locations over the Event days:

- Railway Avenue (at the State School with access to the overpass)
- Charters Towers Road (south of Boundary Road)
- Flinders Street (near the railway station)
- Saunders Street (at the rail overpass)

Q: Can I access businesses inside the race venue?

A: Non accredited pedestrian access is available at all times prior to Friday July 10th. Access throughout the event period is also available provided you have a valid ticket or event issued accreditation pass.

Vehicle access is also available to those businesses at all times prior to Friday July 10th. After road closures come into affect on Tuesday July 7th, vehicle access will only be granted via the corner of Boundary Road and Charters Towers road. Only after hours vehicle access will be granted throughout the event period and all vehicles must possess valid event vehicle accreditation.

THERE WILL BE NO GENERAL VEHICLE ACCESS TO THE ACTUAL RACE CIRCUIT FOLLOWING THE JULY 7TH ROAD CLOSURES.

Q: What time do the gates open?

A: Gates are open between the hours of 7am and 6pm between Friday 10 July and Sunday 12 July. An extended closing time will apply to the Saturday night concert.

Q: Vehicle access to restricted areas?

A: Those streets which are restricted are detailed in Question 2 above and are illustrated on the downloadable pamphlet.

Q: Is there any on street parking near the track?

A: There will be limited on street parking around the venue and is it recommended that patrons utilise either public transport or paid parking opportunities.

Q: Is there any Coach Parking available?

A: Coach parking is available via Ford Street off the southern side of Charters Towers road.
